

ONE ON ONE SOULWINNING CHECKLIST



Today, we are looking for thirsty people. I am passing out bottles of water and telling people about what has quenched my thirst. I am looking for just five minutes of your time.

We are praying for people today. Is there something that we can pray with you about? I am looking for a person with spiritual hunger or spiritual questions.

I am looking for someone who has a physical pain or an injury. Do you have something that we may pray for? Perhaps you have a family member who needs prayer.

In a world seemingly gone crazy, my family and I would like to pray for you and your family. We would like to share about what gives us peace and helps us overcome fear when we face chaos.

Know the Four Pictures of Redemption. God's Creation, Satan's Deception, Jesus Substitution, and Our Restoration. These four pictures answer the question: If God is good, why do bad things happen to good people?



Engage in conversation. Don't use Christian club talk. Use every day conversational language.

Smile. Maintain a pleasant attitude. Be approachable, modest and presentable. (Look in a mirror if necessary!)

Avoid arguments that waste time. **Your personal story** is often a powerful connection with people. What is the Lord doing in your life today? What has he done for you? What he has done for you he will do for others.

Remain open-handed. Put finger pointing aside. Remember Jesus is always pictured with open hands. He is accessible.

Bring each person to a place of decision. Do not fear rejection! You are a seed-planter. You plant and God waters the seed.



Go out "2 By 2" in teams or with a friend or family member.

Use the soul winning cards to capture testimonies and how many people are reached. **Share** this information with the team leader.

Carry contact cards. Take time to **use the QR codes** to connect people to more information and for discipleship.

Be aware of your person and surroundings.

Report in at the required time and location(s).

If you are asked to leave an area check in with your team leader.

Make sure you drink plenty of water and use sun block.



Avoid arguments.

Avoid large, raucous groups especially gangs under the influence. Avoid cults. Recognize that they can take all of your allotted time to witness.



Review the positive and negative encounters from your experience.

Learn from your failures. Capture what you have discovered in your soul-winning journal.

Celebrate your victories. Rejoice in the seeds planted. Go out again!
